## INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS RE: PROCEDURES FOR KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION SEPTEMBER 2019

- 1. To register for **English Kindergarten** do so at your catchment school.
  - North Zone: Sidney, KELSET, Deep Cove
  - Central Zone: Keating, Brentwood
  - South Zone: Cordova Bay, Lochside, Prospect Lake
- 2. To register children for **French Immersion Kindergarten** do so at your FI
- catchment school:
  - Keating Catchment Schools Keating, Brentwood, Cordova Bay, Lochside, Prospect Lake
  - Deep Cove Catchment Schools Sidney, KELSET, Deep Cove
- 3. To register at a school **outside of your catchment area**:
  - Go to your catchment school
  - Complete the District Registration Form
  - Complete an "Out of catchment area application" form
  - Leave all registration forms at the catchment school

(every effort will be made to confirm placements by the end of June when possible – September 17<sup>th</sup> at the latest)

- 4. To **register siblings** of students who currently attend a Saanich Elementary School, please follow steps in Point 3 above to register at your catchment school.
- 5. To complete the District Registration process, you will **need to bring**:
  - Proof of the child's birth date (e.g., Birth Certificate or Passport)
  - 3 Proof of address documents (e.g., Purchase or Tenancy Agreement, Driver's License, utility bill)
  - Child's BC Services Card
- 6. Children shall be placed according to the following SD63 priorities:

1 - re-enrolling students\*\*

4 - non-catchment siblings

2 - catchment area siblings

5 - non-catchment children

3 - catchment area children

6 - out of district children

\*\*A child who, in the previous year, attended the school

7. If your registration information changes between February and September 2019 please inform the school.
