Some examples are: My backpack weighs a ton OR She cried so much she made a lake. Pick your favorite hyperbole, write it down and then illustrate it. Email a picture of your work to Mrs.Cannady.</li> <li>2. Brainstorm with yourself and others to create list of common and your own hyperboles. Remember to catch your reader's attention with a hook at the beginning of your writing. You can write this on paper or complete it on the slide below the choice board titled, <b>"Choice 2"</b>. Your writing should be a minimum of <b>8-10 sentences</b>.</li> <li>2. Read for 30 minutes and complete the <b>'Character Interactions - Reading Response'</b> in Google Classroom. If you are completing this on paper write about a character in your book and give a detailed description of that character. Describe your character in a well written paragraph with 8-10 sentences.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3.
