Examples are ABAB, ABBA, AABB and ABCB. Search through your library at home or EPIC online. Can you find an example of a quatrain verse? Write down the verse and identify each line within the rhyming scheme (using the letters). Be sure to include the name of the book from which you found the verse, the author and illustrator. Email a picture of your work or use Google Classroom. See examples online as well. 2. An onomatopoeia is a word that phonetically imitates or suggests the source of the sound it is describing. Bing, Bang, BOOM! are examples. Brainstorm a list of onomatopoeia words. Discuss with a family member. Can they add even more to the list?
